## THE RHINOCEROS.

$\mathrm{T}_{\text {II Is }}$ wonderful Beaft has a coat of mail, or hard $\mathfrak{k k i n}$, which is difficult to pierce with a fword; a horn projects from his nofe about two fect long as he grows in age; with this he tears up the ground, rips up the elephant, to whom he is a mortal enemy, pulls up trees by their roots, and throws large ftones over his head to a great diftance. His fenfe of finelling is furpriingly acutt: when he fcents any thing he purfues it in a right line, and tears up every thing in its way ; but it is one happinefs that his eyes are exceedingly finall, and fo fixed, that he can only fee ftraight forward, fo that it is eafy to avoid him by flipping affide, as he is a long time in turning himfelf, and longer fill in getting fight again of his object. He will not, however, attack a man unlefs provoked, or unlefs he is dreffed in fcarlet. He feeds principally on Grubs, thiftles, and a plant which refembles the juniper, and which, from his fondnefs of it, is called Rhinoceros-bufh.
They are natives of Africa and Afia. The

Rlinoceros of which this is the figure was brought from the Great Mogul＇s Enipire，and was prefented to an Euglifh Nobleman by an Eaftern Rajah，as a rarity feldom to be met with；and his Lordhip has complimented the curious of his native country，by prefenting him to a Genteman who has brought him home for their infpection．

He arrived in London the 5 th of June $\mathbf{1 7 9 0}$ ， and was purchafed by Mr ．Clark，for a large fum，for the infpection of thofe who admire the wonderful productions of the Creator on ani－ mated nature，at one fhilling each perfon．This wonderful Herculean Quadruped is faid to be more compact in his formation and ftronger made than the Elephant，and that he weighs near a ton weight．He is now about three years old，and in perfect health．
