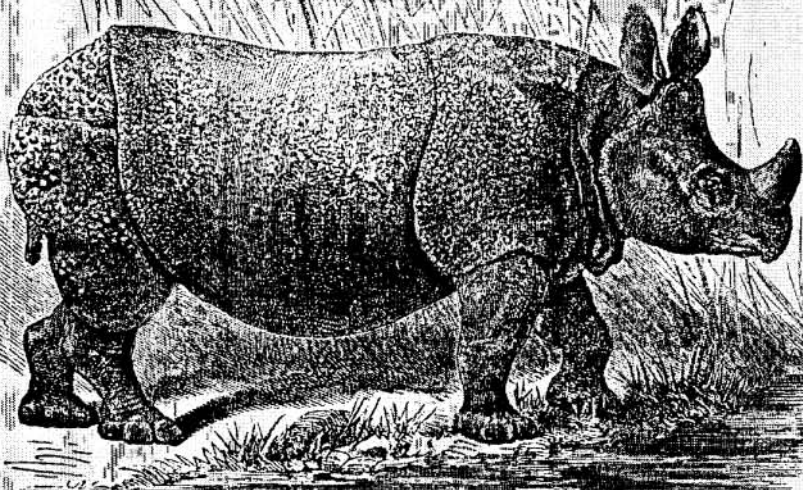

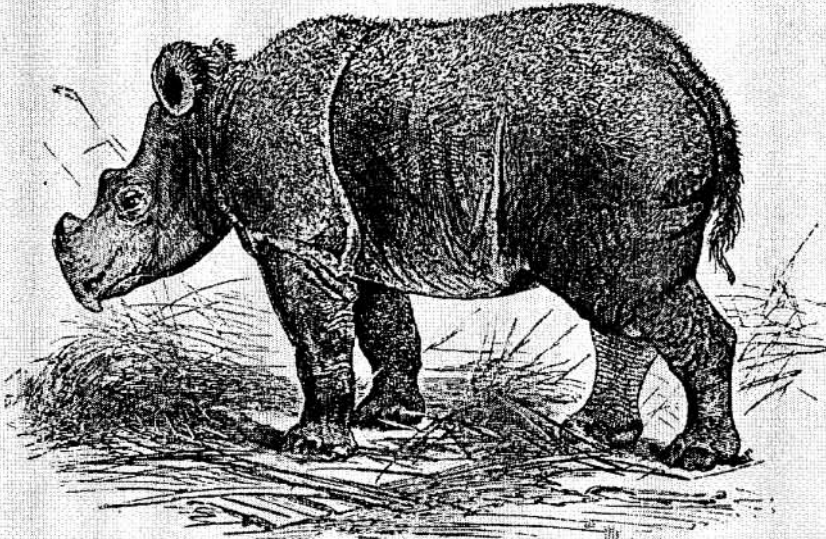

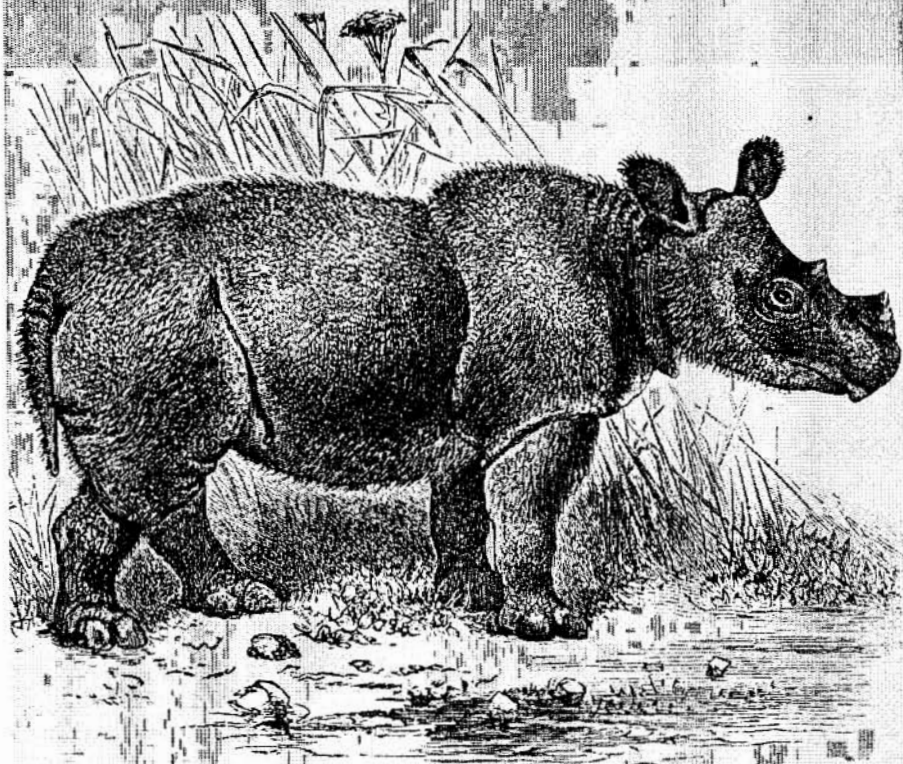
(Fig. 16, p. 140.)

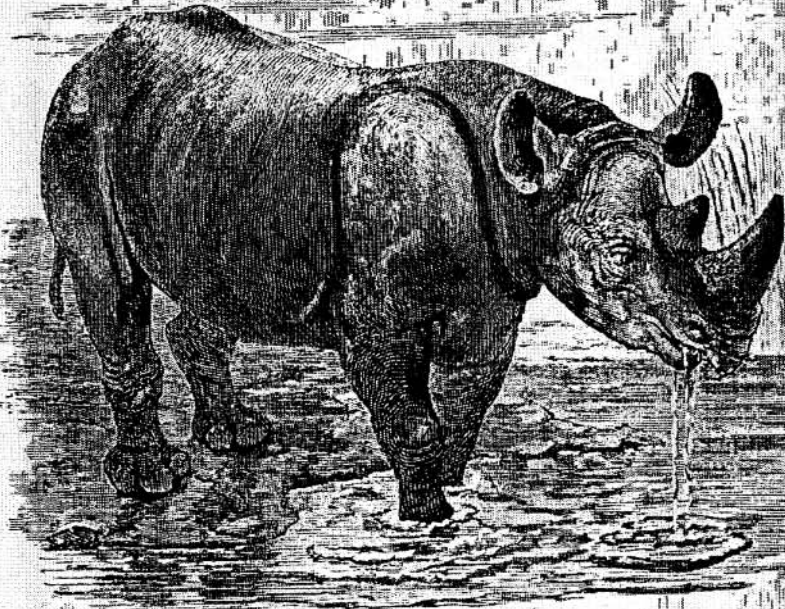
Rhinoceros sumatrensis. ('Nature,' vol. vi, p. 518.)
