During August, 1964, two special zoo inhabitants arrived: on August 14th, "Jumbolino", the baby African bull Elephant about two and a half years of age; and on August 9th, "Congola", a male six-year-old Black-faced Chimpanzee.

Edmonton - Alberta - Canada

Some outstanding births and arrivals have occurred in 1964 at Al Oeming's Alberta Game Farm. Significant births include: 2 Snow Leopards, 1 Père David Deer, 1 Rocky Mountain Goat (*Oreamnos montanus*), 3 Barren Ground Musk Ox (*Ovibos m. moschatus*), and 5 Stone Mountain Sheep (*Ovis dalli stonei*).

New arrivals include a pair of White Rhinos from the Umfolozi Game Preserve in Zululand, Natal, and 6 Dall's Sheep (*Ovis d. dalli*) from the McKenzie Mountains of the Northwest Territories.

Glasgow - Scotland

Glasgow Zoo have decided to specialise in developing high quality native domesticated animals, notably Highland cattle and Shetland ponies. We have purchased one cow and three heifers in calf, pedigree Highland cattle of the highest quality and Shetland ponies from the leading stable in Britain. Three foals were born this autumn. An open lion den will be erected this winter, with a moat at the front. A natural spacious area will be a big feature of the enclosure. Three lion cubs have been bred and reared in 1964. Among the recent purchases are a pair of young pumas bought from London Zoo. Gates at Glasgow Zoo in 1964 are over 12,000 up on 1963.
