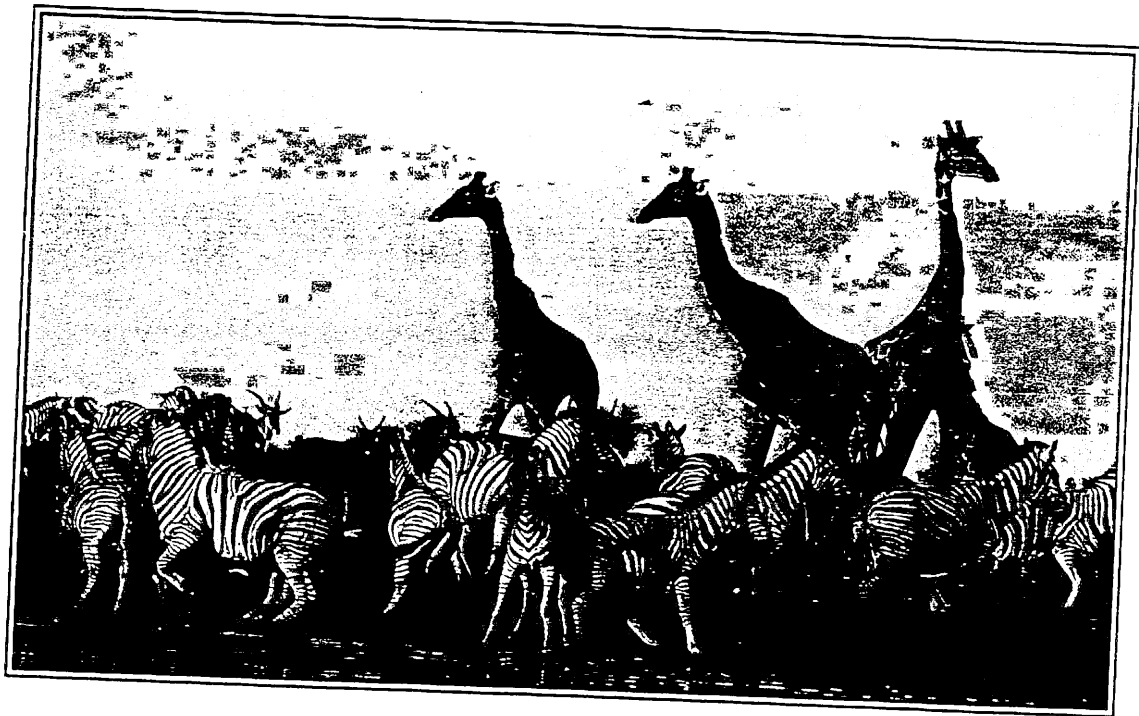

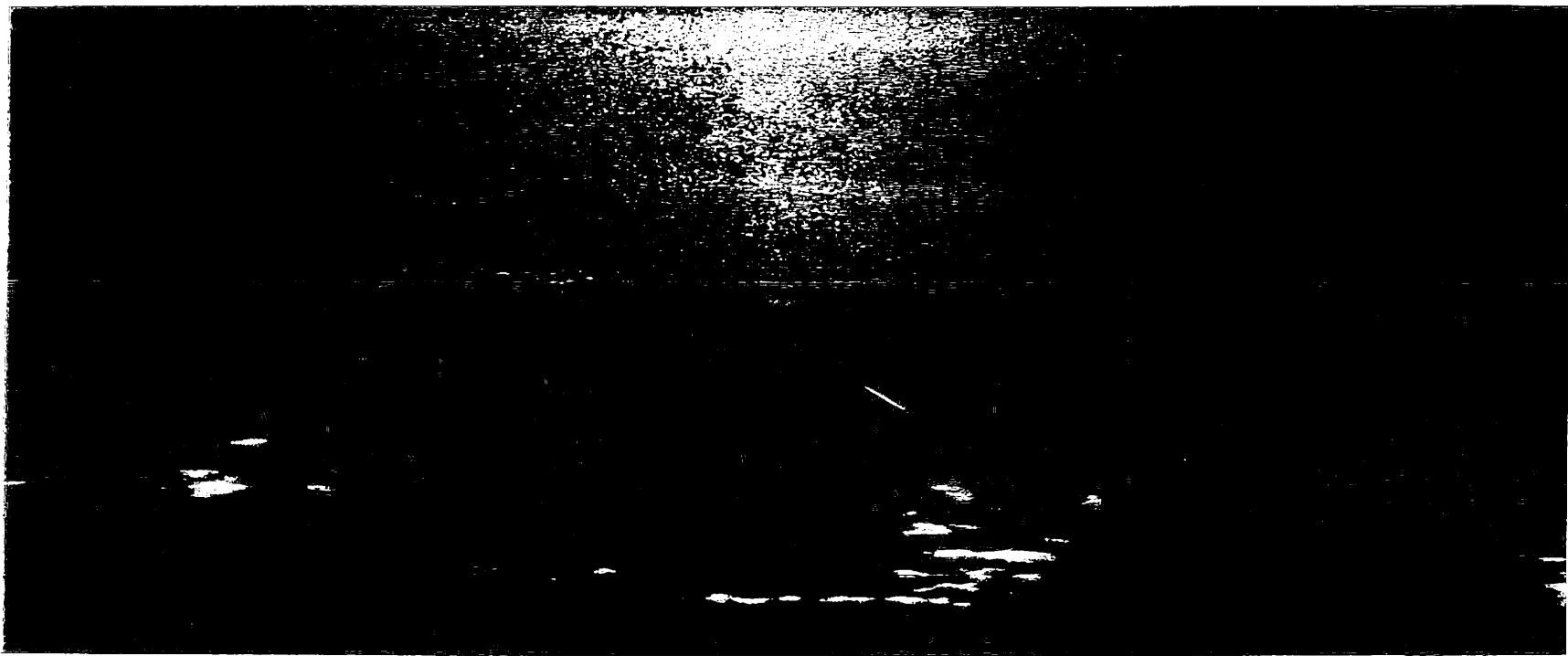
# ETOSHA
