October hatchlings include American Widgeon, Bartlett's Pigeon, Black-billed Tree Duck, Chilean Pintail, 9 Crested Wood Partridge, Indian Spotbill, 4 Maned Geese, Purple Honeycreeper, Razor-billed Curassow, 2 Red-crested Pochard, 9 Ringed Teal and 4 Lesser Scaup. Newcomers: 1 Black Squirrel, 3 Lace Monitor, 1 Northern Copperhead, 1 Bufflehead, 2 Hooded Merganser, 2 Red-cheeked Cordon-bleu and 2 Ringed Teal.

Newcomers: 1.1 Angolan Roan Antelope, 1.0 Grant's Zebra, 0.1 Black Rhino, and 1.1 Abyssinian Soemmering's Gazelle.
On 11th October, 1972 the long-awaited baby White Rhino was born at the San Diego Wild Animal Park.
Parents of the 125-pound male calf are 'Uhtandi', a female who arrived from South Africa in 1971; and 'Mandhla' a male who had been exhibited at the San Diego Zoo since 1962 but was moved to the Park in 1971.
The new baby is only the second White Rhino conceived and born in captivity in the United States and the third in the world.
During October and November a New Guinea Scrub Wallaby was born, and 1.2 Tule Wapiti and 4.4 Arabian Oryx arrived at San Diego Wild Animal Park. (Clyde A. Hill)
