Four King Penguins joined the Penguin colony at the end of April and we now have eight King Penguins and five Humboldt's. Newcomers to the Reptile House are four Western Diamond-back Rattlesnakes, two Boa constrictors and an African Python. "Sugar" and "Spice", a pair of Black Spider Monkeys were recent purchases, together with a baby Giant Anteater.

Cologne - Germany

Recent new additions in the Cologne Zoo's collection are: 2-2 Cinnamon Herons (*Ixobrychus cinnamomeus*); two Rails (*Hydrophasianus chirurgus*); 13 Crowned Pigeons (*Goura cristata*); 1-2 Ocellated Turkeys (*Agriocharis ocellata*); 1-1 Whistling Swans (*Cygnus columbianus columbianus*); 1-0 Cock of the Rock; 4-3 Hume's Pheasants; 0-1 Woolly Monkey; 0-1 Cheetah; 1-0 Lion Marmoset; one White-eared Marmoset; 0-1 Puma; 0-1 Lynx and two Raccoons.

Births during March till June include: 0-2 Lion cubs; 1-1 Moufflon; 1-0 Bactrian Camel; 0-1 Blackbuck and 0-1 White Yak.

Dudley - England

Last year the Sheik of Bahrein presented our Zoo with a pair of dromedaries from his own herd. Due to lack of proper care during the voyage, the animals arrived in very poor condition and full of sores. We were not able to save them. Another pair was given to us earlier in the year to make up for the loss. In order not to experience the same tragedy, one of our keepers was sent to Bahrein to look after the animals on their voyage.

Animals born here from January to June:

5 Barbary Sheep, 2 Nubian Goats, 1 Red Kangaroo, 2 Bennet's Wallabies, 2 Red Deer, 1 Axis Deer, 1 American Bison, 1 Donkey, 1 Grant's Zebra, 1 Moufflon and 7 Coypu-rats. One Wallaby, whose mother was found killed, is being successfully hand-reared. — 15 Budgerigars, 4 Ring-necked Parakeets and 18 Barbary Doves were hatched.

New Arrivals: 3 Donkeys, 1 ♂ Himalayan Bear, 3 Spider Monkeys, 1 ♀ Grant's Zebra, 1 ♂ and 2 ♀ Bay Lynx, 1 Humboldt's Woolly Monkey, 1 Demoiselle Crane, 5 Sarus Cranes, 6 Ornate Lorakeets, 6 Black-kapped Lories, 4 Sulphur-crested Cockatoos, 4 Lesser Sulphur-crested Cockatoos, 1 Japanese Hill Mynah, 2 pair Common Shelduck, 2 pairs Common Shoveller, 1 ♀ and 3 ♂ Carolina, 2 ♀ and 6 ♂ Mandarin, 1 Tufted Duck, 1 American Widgeon, 1 European Widgeon, 2 Common Pintail, 1 Ruddy Shelduck, 1 Common Pochard, 1 White-eyed Pochard, 1 Blue-winged Teal, 1 Cinnamon Teal, — 6 Mangrove Snakes, 6 Sea-horses, and in exchange from a reptile park in Australia: 4 Carpet Pythons, 6 Diamond Pythons, 4 Amethystine Pythons, 4 Bearded Lizzards, 12 Stump-tailed Skinks, 12 Blue-tongued Skinks, 2 Lace Monitors.

The large ravine at the East-side of the zoo has been filled in with rubble. After the ground has settled, it will be developed for antelope enclosures. For the time being it is made into two tracks for the camel and pony rides.
