WEST-BERLIN — GERMANY

In the period July-September 1967 the following new acquisitions are reported.

CHESTER — ENGLAND

The first Rhino to be born at Chester Zoo arrived on 10th September; it is a Black Rhino, weighing at birth about 100 lbs.

Very noteworthy is the arrival of a female Tuatara as a mate for the male at the zoo since 1963.

Among the new arrivals in September 1967 are one male and two female Blesboks, which were received from Frankfurt Zoo. Others are two Fat-tailed Geckoes (*Eublepharis macularis*), a four-foot-long Cayman, a Sugar Glider, and two Russell's Vipers.
