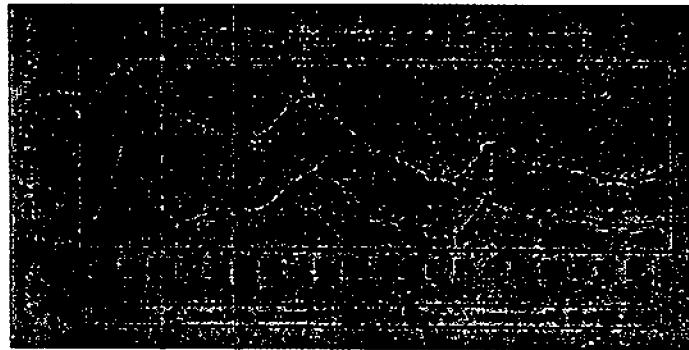

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From the graphs above, it is clear that real prices for nyalas, tsessebes and giraffes generally are increasing or are being maintained, while real price trends for the rest of the species are starting to show declines to a greater or lesser extent. This again suggests that market maturity might have been reached in the case of abundant game, but not for rare game.

Perspective on price trends

It is necessary to put the observed real price declines in the game industry over the past year or two, into perspective. Graph 6 (predictions for 2000) shows the position with the game industry's main competitor for natural resources, i.e. the beef cattle industry.

Long periods of real price declines and shorter periods of real price increases are evident from Graph 6, making the South African beef industry a classic example of a mature livestock industry. The decline in real prices in the beef industry is worse than any case of real price declines in the game industry. In fact, producer prices of beef and weaners have shown almost constant real declines since 1980, despite periods of real price increases. From this it can be concluded that it would not be wise for investors in the game industry to turn back to serving the already saturated mass markets of the beef cattle industry.

Conclusion

It can be accepted that live game prices are a derivative of prices received by game farmers for trophy and meat hunting, as well as tourism. The levelling off of real prices of certain game species over the past few years may suggest the start of market maturity for some game industry products and services. Game auction prices could increase further over the short term due to farmers restocking game, following good rainfall in the northern parts of the country. Although this process of restocking should be seen as a short term phenomenon, it could over the longer term expedite the process of reaching the market maturity stage.

If the game industry indeed reaches the mature livestock industry phase, relatively low returns on the high capital investments in this industry could be expected, which is already the case with the beef cattle industry. It has been pointed out by the leadership in the game industry that the enlargement of current markets and the development of new markets, would eventually be the only solution to keep the South African game industry in a growth phase.

Judged by the continuously rising volumes and turnover (actual and real) on game auctions over the past nine years, it seems that the game industry in general is still in a healthy financial state, despite recent real declines in prices of certain game species. ■
