




I FOSSILI DEL FIUME PO

CATALOGO DEI MAMMIFERI DELLE ALLUVIONI QUATERNARIE DEL MUSEO NATURALISTICO PALEONTOLOGICO DI SAN DANIELE PO (CR)

The full volume – which represents the catalogue of the Museo Paleoantropologico di San Daniele Po fossil collection – consists of 227 pages with numerous illustrations of the remains.

Illustrations apart, it contains an introduction, an exhaustive chapter on the geology of lower Pianura Padana territory, a detailed description of each specimen preserved in the museum collection as well as over than 20 reconstructions of fossil mammals by the palaeontologist Simone Cau.

Two of the specimens belong to rhinoceros species: a fourth upper molar ascribed to *Stephanorhinus* sp. (inv. MSDP 49, pp 74 and 183) as well as a second upper molar attributed to *Coelodonta antiquitatis* (Blum.) (inv. MSDP 252, pp 74 and 221).

On November 4th 2013, the Museo Paleoantropologico di San Daniele Po has been enriched by an extraordinary "new entry" represented by a rhinoceros skull assigned to *Stephanorhinus kirchbegensis* (Jäger) found in exceptional shape (only the left third upper molar is missing) on a bank of the Po near S. Daniele Po.

Till today, it represents the sole *Stephanorhinus kirchbegensis* skull ever found in Italy and one of the very few recovered on Eurasian territory.
