MR T. R. HUBBACK'S RHINOCEROS.

SIR,—I notice that an inaccuracy has crept in regarding the capture of the *R. sondaicus* described in your issue of June 4. This animal was not trapped by means of a pitfall, but was shot by Mr T. R. Hubback after many days of steady tracking. When killed the beast collapsed into a hollow, back downwards, and could not be moved, and consequently had to be skinned in that position.
