This is certainly a very remarkable photograph taken by Mr. Bengt Berg in the Bengal Rhino Sanctuary, showing as it does a pair of Indian rhinos by daylight. There are probably not more than a few hundred of these great beasts left at the present time, and to have photographed this domestic interlude by day was a triumphant reward for the many hours of preparation, observation and disappointment which is the usual lot of the big game photographer. The Bengal Rhino Reserve is now let by the Bengal Government for limited shooting, though of course the rhinos are protected, and the income therefrom goes towards the cost of protecting one of the rarest and certainly one of the most interesting animals in the world.
