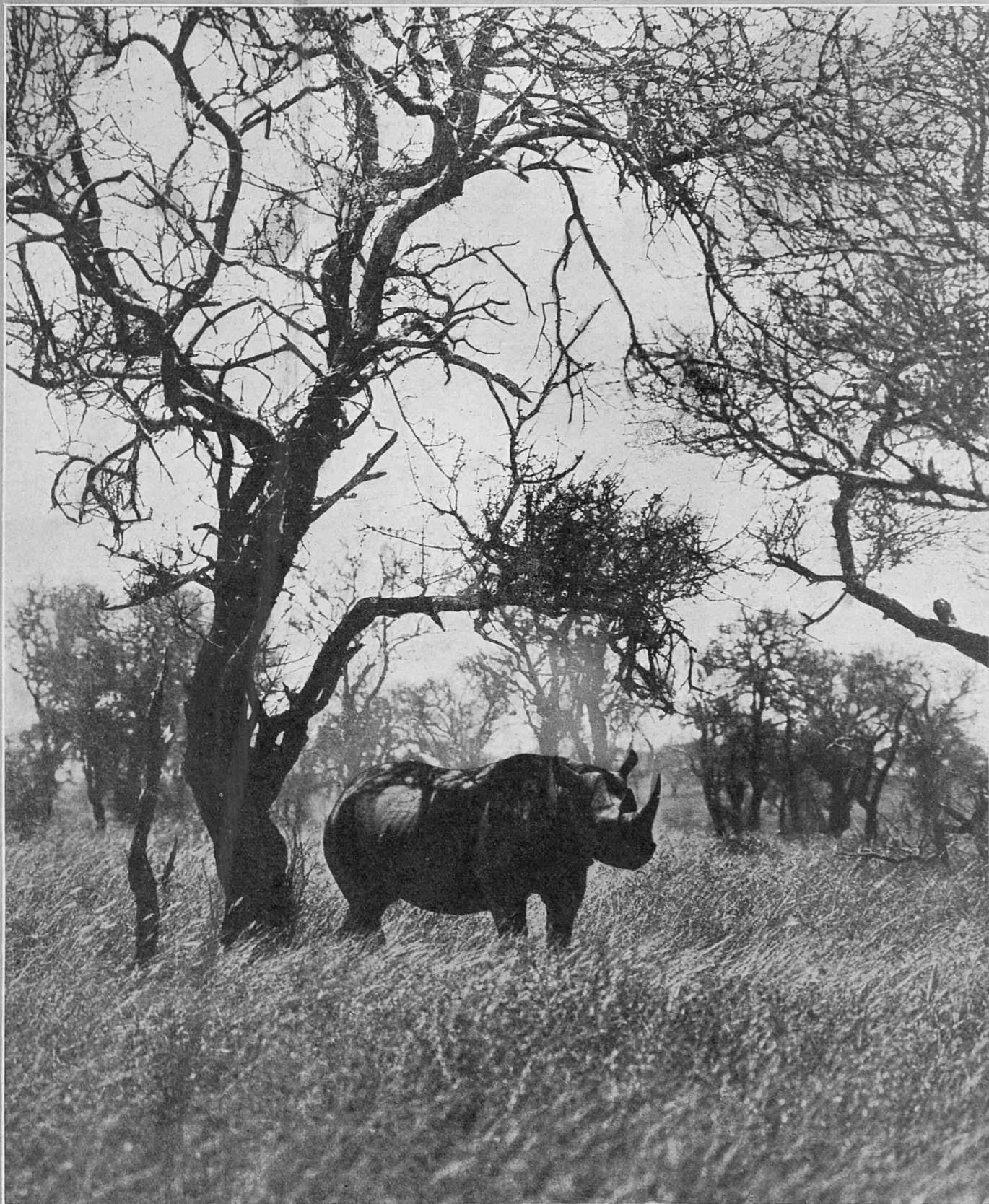


## A WONDERLAND OF BIG GAME: BRITISH EAST AFRICA.



## HUNTED BY THE CAMERA! THE WANDERING RHINO.

The man who hunts big game with a camera will have the same satisfaction in showing a picture like "The Wandering Rhino" as will the hunter who has brought home a head to display. This picture is from "The Wonderland of Big Game," a film taken by Major A. R. Dugmore during a five-months expedition in British East Africa, and now being exhibited by Natural Films, Ltd., at The Polytechnic Hall. The camera hunter runs his risks, for he has to be within shorter range than the man with a gun, and much skill in stalking is necessary. The rhino wanders long distances while he is feeding on small plants during the night, and generally devotes the day to sleep. His reputation for savage attacks on travellers is not deserved, according to some authorities, who put his rush down to panic and a desire to clear quickly; his size and his stupidity are among the reasons given for his rapid disappearance from many of his old resorts.
