

DEATH OF THE RHINOCEROS AT THE CALCUTTA ZOO.—All visitors to the Zoo will, we feel sure, be sorry to learn that young rhinoceros has come to an untimely end. On Sunday morning he was found dead, floating in the tank in his enclosure, and though it was suggested that he might have died from snake-bite or committed suicide, a *post mortem* examination showed that death resulted from chronic pleurisy.
