We hear from Ascot-heath races, that the Rhinoceros, or real Unicorn, which was exhibited before their Majesties and the Royal Family at Windsor Lodge, on Saturday the 1st of June, will be at our fair on Monday next, the 24th instant. That most wonderful of all animals, which has so much engaged the attention of the naturalists for ages past, the Rhinoceros, from the empire of the Great Mogul.— This infant animal is only four years old, and weighs 30 hundred weight; from this specimen it evidently appears, that the Rhinoceros is more compact in his formation, and stronger made than the elephant, with superior strength, an impenetrable coat of mail, a formidable horn on his nose, and an imperious spirit, he bids defiance to the whole brute creation; he is not violent, except when irritated or discomposed for want of food. This natural curiosity was a present from an Eastern Nabob to a great personage in India. The above animal has been exhibited at the Lyceum in the Strand, London, with universal applause, it being the only one in this kingdom.
