
BLACK RHINO BORN AT CHEYENNE MOUNTAIN ZOO

A male black rhino was born at the Cheyenne Mountain Zoological Park, Colorado Springs, on 20 October 1993. This represents the first birth for the parents and the first viable black rhino birth at the zoo since 1972. The mother is on loan from the San Francisco Zoological Gardens. The neonate was discovered at less than two hours old hypothermic and in lateral recumbency. He was removed to increase body temperature and given colostrum. After approximately four hours, he was reintroduced to the mother, where he is doing well.
