The Knoxville Zoological Gardens, Tennessee, recently announced the births of 1.1 southern white rhinos. The female was born on 29 July 1998 and the male on 23 August 1998. Both calves are on exhibit with their mothers and doing fine.

The zoo also announced their 57th red panda birth. A female red panda was born on 4 July 1998. Both the rhino and red panda programs represent two of the zoo's most successful mammal AZA SSP programs. *S. Stines*
