NASHVILLE ZOO

Nashville, Tennessee

The Zoo announced the birth of a male and female clouded leopard on 30 June. The Zoo now has 16 clouded leopards in their care. In total, Nashville Zoo has celebrated the birth of 42 clouded leopards since 2009.



POTTER PARK ZOO

Lansing, Michigan

The Zoo's red panda Maliha gave birth to a cub on 21 July 2022. This is Maliha's second successful litter with the cub's father Deagan-Reid. Veterinary staff will continue to conduct regular wellness checks in the coming weeks to monitor his growth and development.



EL PASO ZOO

El Paso, Texas

The Zoo announced the birth of its newest orangutan born on 9 June 2022. This marks the second orangutan birth at the El Paso Zoo for parents Ibu and Butch. Their first daughter, Khaleesi, was born seven years ago and is still at the El Paso Zoo.



LION COUNTRY SAFARI

West Palm Beach, Florida

Lion Country Safari welcomed a female southern white rhinoceros calf to its herd on 6 August 2022, the third calf born at the park in less than a year. She is a significant contribution to the White Rhinoceros Species Survival Plan®.



BREVARD ZOO

Melbourne, Florida

The Zoo welcomed the first Chilean flamingo chick to be born to its flock in early September. While the Zoo has been home to Chilean flamingos since 1994, its flock has never laid eggs before.



LAKE SUPERIOR ZOO

Duluth, Minnesota

A male Chinese goral was born at the Zoo on June 21, 2022. The name Xaizhi (Zai-Shee) has been chosen as it is Chinese for summer solstice, the day the baby was born. Chinese gorals are managed by an SSP and are a vulnerable species.
